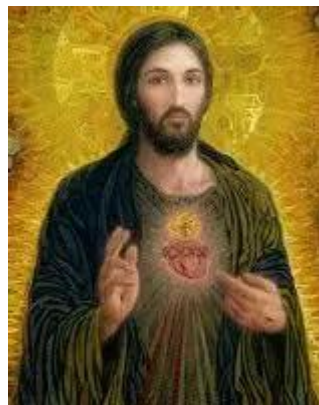

Amen.



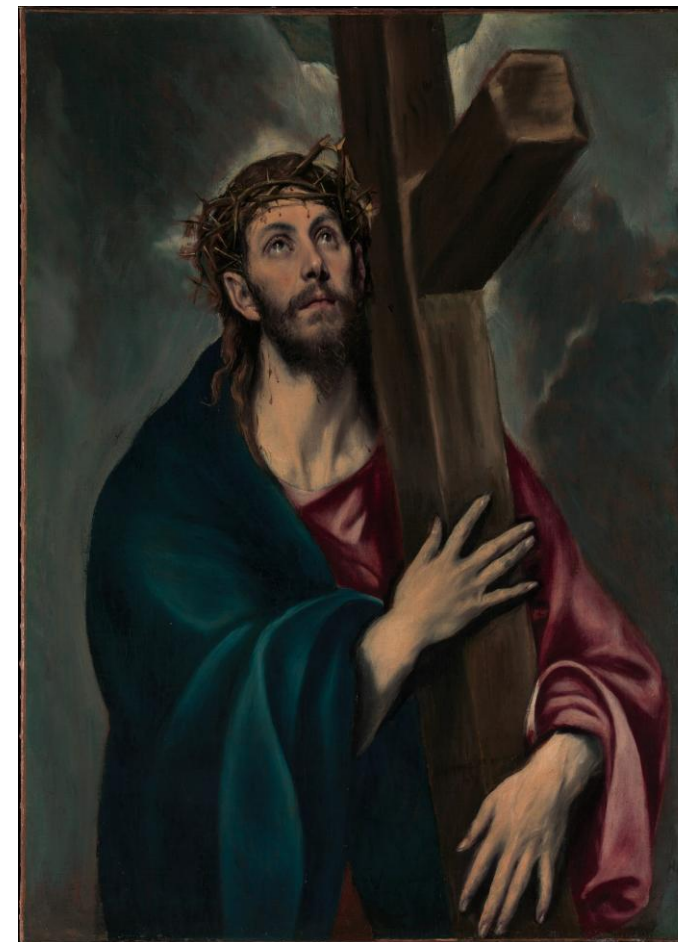

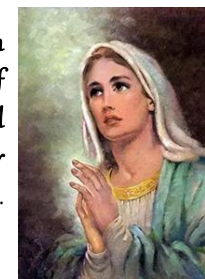
PARISH LIBRARY

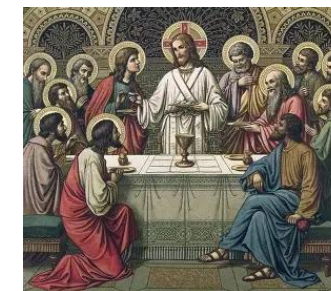
